Scope: Motion 24-413 transfers funding from pending grants to the Energy

Assistance Program.

The Department of Commerce Low Income Household Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Grants provide funding for energy assistance services to low-income households. An increase in 2024 grant funding resulted in the need for additional seasonal staff, beyond what was anticipated in the approved 2024 budget. This transfer will enable necessary services

to Energy Assistance Clients through the end of 2024.

These activities were not anticipated during the 2024 budget process. An offsetting reduction is being made from Human Services Pending Grants.
