Existing District boundaries surround the Sparman Annexation area, making it a donut hole in the District. The Sparman Annexation area is also within the incorporated area of the City of Lake Stevens.

Owners of 100% of the assessed value have signed the petition. The District submitted the Notice of Intention (NOI) to the BRB for the Sparman Annexation on July 13, 2023, and then amended	
Approved as to Form: □Yes □No ⊠N/A	that notice on September 1 (BRB File No. 2023-01). As a sewer district annexation, the review period is 30 days (RCW 57.02.040(2)). The 30-day review period for the County Council to act expires on October 1, 2023. The BRB, consistent with its annexation review procedures outlined in Chapter 2.77 SCC, distributed the NOI to County departments including PDS.	

The annexation meets criteria in RCW 57.02.040(3), SCC 2.77.040, and other applicable requirements. Details are available in a staff report from PDS dated September 13, 2023. There are no known conflicts with policy or other reasons for the annexation to not proceed.
