Subject: Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) grant application - Interurban Trail.

Scope: The RCO is currently accepting grant applications. Snohomish County Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation desires to apply for RCO grants to support rehabilitation along the Interurban Trail. Background: A grant from RCO is sought to remove and replace approximately 11,840 square feet of root lifted asphalt that has become a health and safety issue within the interurban trail. The effected area needs to have the roots removed, a root barrier installed, along with a crushed rock base, repaving, and sealed edges to the section of trail.
