BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The work to be performed under this Bid, ITB-25-0625RB Acrylic Waterborne Traffic Line Paint Materials Supply includes the supply and delivery of Type I – Rapid Dry Acrylic Waterborne Traffic Line Paint, in both white and yellow, for use by the Snohomish County Roads Maintenance Division. Award recommendation as follows: Primary Supplier: Ennis-Flint. Secondary Supplier (if the Primary is not available): Rodda-Miller Paint Company, and Tertiary Supplier: Aramsco, Inc. Materials shall meet all technical specifications outlined in the solicitation, including applicable ASTM requirements and delivery provisions.

BIDDERS:

1. **Ennis-Flint - \$529,600.00**
2. **Rodda-Miller Paint Company - \$589,200.00**
3. **Aramsco, Inc. - \$593,000.00**

AWARD AUTHORITY:

This Bid award recommendation is before the County Council for approval to award in accordance with Snohomish County Code section 3.04.120, "Formal sealed bidding," and section 3.04.140(5), "Award, execution, by whom," which establish the County Council as the award authority for contracts subject to bidding requirements greater than \$500,000. The County Council approves this Bid Award and authorizes the County Executive or designee to execute Agreements and subsequent amendments for the products and services defined in the Bid.

AWARD RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the County award contracts to multiple vendors in accordance with the Bid's Method of Award provisions to ensure continuity of supply and operational flexibility.
