# PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 23-072 RELATING TO STORM AND SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT; AMENDING SCC 25.20.055 TO EXTEND SERVICE CHARGES FOR LAKE KETCHUM RESTORATION

<u>Summary:</u> The ordinance amends Chapter 25.20.055 Snohomish County Code (SCC) extends Lake Ketchum Restoration service charges for 5 years with a moderate increase in charges. Lake Ketchum previously suffered from chronic toxic algal blooms caused by high phosphorus pollution. Toxic algae blooms are a threat to public and environment health and as a result, public use and enjoyment of the lake are severely impaired. A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

Section 1. Adopts findings of fact.

Section 2. Amends SCC 25.20.055 to reflect the new period from January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2028, for rate categories and additional annual service charges for real property abutting Lake Ketchum as follows:

Annual Service Charge for Lake Ketchum Restoration

Timital Control Charge for Land Hotel and Hotel and Hotel	
Rate Category	Annual Service Charge
Lake Front	((\$175.00))\$200.00 per parcel of real property abutting the shoreline of Lake Ketchum
Community Beach Lot	((\$35.00))\$40.00 per parcel of real property with an undivided ownership interest in lake front real property used for common beach access

Section 3. Outlines severability and savings.
