<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approve and authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment 3 between Snohomish County and Kronos Incorporated, under SCC 3.04.140(8).

Background: In 2021, Snohomish County Public Works started a new electronic timekeeping and attendance system under a software as a service agreement with Kronos, Incorporated, through RFP-17-19SB. Implementation of this system reduced annual labor hours required for timekeeping activities. The Airport was added in 2022 with Dimensions software and in 2023 added additional specialized software for fire/emergency services, operating within FAA/Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting Fire Department 24-7 environment.
