**Subject:** Professional Services Agreement SWMCC11-23 with AmTest Inc. for Water

and Sediment Laboratory Testing and Analysis.

**Scope:** For continued compliance with the County's National Pollution Discharge

Elimination System Municipal Stormwater Permit (NPDES), regular, complete water and sediment laboratory testing and analysis of the County's streams is required. The proposed contract allows for

uninterrupted compliance.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approve and authorize the County Executive to sign the Professional Services Agreement SWMCC11-13 with AmTest Inc., and further authorizes the Director of Conservation and Natural Resources to approve amendments not to exceed 20% (\$115,000) of the total contract amount, under SCC 3.04.190.

<u>Background:</u> The County selected AmTest Inc. through RFP-23-079RB following all established Federal, State and County policies. Snohomish County has determined a need for specialized skills of a laboratory to complete water and sediment laboratory testing and analysis, the results of which are used in the compliance of the County's NPDES and the implementation of various programs. These programs include Water Quality Compliant Investigations, Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, and <u>State of our Waters</u>.
