<u>Summary:</u> The County acting through the Snohomish County Department of Emergency Management, operates as a local organization for emergency management. In order to assist other jurisdictions within Snohomish County, the County will enter into interlocal agreements to provide coordinated emergency management services. This ordinance approves form agreements with cities and tribes for emergency management services and establishes a per capita rate of \$1.44 for 2025. The service charge will be adjusted annually based on population data and adjusted by the Bureau of Labor Statistic Consumer Price Index.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
