## **Consideration**

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-543 which would approve the 2023 Transition Agreement between Snohomish County and the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 1811.

## **Background**

On June 8th Council approved a Notice to withdraw from the Snohomish Health District through Motion 22-248<sup>1</sup>. These actions set in motion the integration of the Health District into the County, which must take place by the end of the year.

On October 26<sup>th</sup>, Council approved three ordinances necessary to effectuate the integration of the Health District into the County.<sup>2</sup>

Pending Council Action, Ordinance 22-067<sup>3</sup> establishes initial terms of employment of county employees formerly employed by the Snohomish Health District; the Public Hearing is scheduled for December 14, 2022.

## **Current Proposal**

Scope: Motion 22-543 requests Council approve the transition agreement and authorize the County Executive to sign the agreement; at the time of this Staff Report drafting, the full ratification of the agreement is pending and anticipated by December 13, 2022.

The transition agreement covers:

Insurance Benefits, Wages, Longevity Pay, Bilingual Premium Pay, Leave Accruals, Sick Leave Cash Out, Floating Holidays, Probationary Periods, Deferred Compensation, VEBA, Grievance Procedures, and Compensatory Time-Off.

Duration: January 1, 2023. The agreement will continue in full force and effect for a period not to exceed six (6) years or until a full collective bargaining agreement is agreed to, whichever is later.
