The developmental disabilities program receives funds from governmental and public/private grants to support its program authority. The Board consists of not more

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than 15 members. The membership's composition pursuant to $\underline{SCC 2.52.030}$ is to be as follows:

- 1 member from each council district;
- At least 5 members with developmental disabilities or with family members with developmental disabilities (community advocates); and
- Other members who are knowledgeable of or interested in community support for people with developmental disabilities and their families (at large).

Members are limited to serving three consecutive terms. Appointees who have served three consecutive full terms may be considered for appointment after one year of separation from the board. Susan Lakey was first appointed to the board in 2022 through <u>Motion 22-104</u>.

Requested Action:

- 1. For Council to make a verbal motion amending the enacting clause by deleting "beginning upon confirmation" and inserting "beginning March 24, 2025".
- 2. For Council to consider taking action.
