



APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BOTHELL CONCERNING RECIPROCAL MITIGATION OF TRANSPORTATION IMPACTS FROM DEVELOPMENT
Summary: A newly negotiated interlocal agreement is proposed concerning reciprocal mitigation of transportation impacts from development. The previous agreement relied on the cost of a project as the basis for calculating mitigation. New formulas are proposed that rely on the percentage of boundary-crossing trips (peak-hour ADT), that will strengthen safety by requiring mitigation of inadequate road conditions and introduce updated provisions for ultimate capacity and multimodal corridors.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.




