BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

On an annual basis Information Services embarks on a Technology Replacement Program (TRP) to replace between 15-20% of the oldest client computing systems in the County.

The primary purpose of the TRP program is to ensure the reliability of end user computing devices, limit or eliminate downtime due to failures and to take advantage of new technology. By focusing on the oldest systems Information Services ensures that customers have equal and reliable access to County systems and that the user experience stays relatively consistent from office to office.

A competitive Invitation to Bid was issued to obtain best pricing for Surface products and equipment for the County's TRP program. Nin responsive bids were received; the lowest overall bid was offered by Zones LLC.
