## **Background:**

In Snohomish County, flooding is a significant natural hazard. Floods impact individuals and communities, resulting in social, economic, and environmental consequences. Floods can result in loss of human life, damage to property, and destruction of agricultural products. General infrastructure such as utilities, roads, bridges, and communication technology can be damaged and disrupted. Surface Water Management seeks to study the existing flood management structures in the county and recommend potential improvements to governance and funding of floodplain management. The County and WSU wish to establish a contractual relationship to conduct the flood management study identified herein.
