# **CALL TO ORDER**

1. Amended Ordinance 23-067, relating to sponsorships and licenses at County Parks and the Fair Park, amending Chapters 2.32 SCC and adding new Sections to Chapters 2.16 and 2.32 SCC

Council Chair Mead opened the hearing and the clerk read the ordinance title into the record.

Deb Bell, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided an overview of the proposed Code amendments to allow for licenses and sponsorship agreements for contributions to park properties and the Evergreen State Fairgrounds. She also explained Proposed Amendment 1, which establishes a monetary threshold amount for sponsorships requiring Council review and approval, as well as the submittal of an annual sponsorship report to the Council.

Tom Teigen, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Director, responded to questions and explained that some sponsorships may be used Capital Improvement Projects, while others would be used for park maintenance and operations. He noted that the sponsorship agreements will outline the scope of work and use of the funds.

Council Chair Mead opened the hearing for public testimony. There being no persons present wishing to testify, he closed the testimony portion of the hearing calling for a motion or discussion of the Council.

**ACTION:** Council Vice-Chair Nehring made a motion to approve Ordinance 23-067. Councilmember Dunn seconded the motion.

Councilmember Dunn made a motion to approve Proposed Amendment 1. Council Vice-Chair Nehring seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The clerk called the roll and the motion to approve Ordinance 23-067, as amended, carried unanimously.
