Consideration

The proposal would authorize the County Executive to execute an amendment to the parking rates and charges as allowed by Snohomish County Code 3.09.030 (3)¹.

Background

Council approved parking rates through Amended Motion 18-344² and set employee monthly parking rates at \$70 per month for a single-occupant vehicle festival parking space.

The Facilities & Fleet, Parking Management Division has developed a program for two (2) employees who are telecommuting to share the usage and monthly cost of a single festival parking stall in the Snohomish County parking garage. The department proposes, and the County Executive's Office recommends, amending the current parking rate structure to include the shared monthly cost of an employee festival parking space.

The current cost of an employee festival parking space is \$70 per month; the shared parking rate is proposed at \$35 per month per employee for a total of \$70 per month. No other changes to the parking rates are proposed at this time.

Any changes to the parking rates require approval by the County Council by Motion.

Current Proposal

Scope: To allow two Snohomish County employees to share a single parking space, where they split the cost of the established rate (\$70) per month as two rates of \$35 each per month requires approval by the County Council by motion; and that the parking rates and charges on Exhibit A be approved to commence July 1, 2021.

Duration: Effective Date- 7/01/2021 until modified by motion
