NOTICE OF ENACTMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on October 19, 2022, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance 22-040, which shall be effective November 12, 2022:

ORDINANCE NO. 22-040

RELATED TO THE 2022 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY FUND 505 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR THE ENTERPRISE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM AND CUSTOMER & WORKSTATION PROGRAM

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: An emergency appropriation in the Information Technology Fund 505, for the 2022 budget year, in the amount of \$428,048 is necessary to provide expenditure authority for unanticipated costs related to maintaining network availability and security of County information and data for the County's remote workforce.

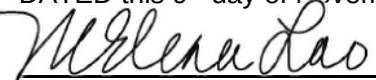

Section 3. The County Council finds that there is need for such emergency appropriation to fund projects maintaining network availability and security of County information and data for the County's remote workforce. The initial appropriation of this funding source occurred on November 3, 2021, just days prior to the adoption of the 2022 budget. A reasonable estimate of related expenditure was not able to be calculated and due to supply chain issues arising from the pandemic, anticipating delivery of products already on order was not possible. Therefore, the full extent of need for this appropriation was not known and could not have been determined prior to the adoption of the 2022 budget. The Council therefore finds that the need for the appropriation authorized by this ordinance constitutes a public emergency that could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of budget approval and appropriation for the year 2022 and hereby authorizes the appropriation.

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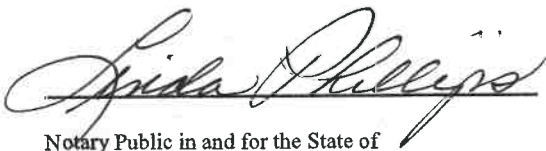

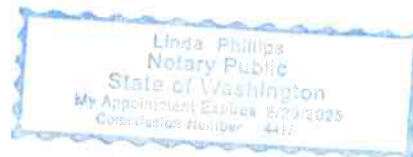
