Automatically Eligible:

- Children in Foster Care
- Families Experiencing Homelessness
- Families receiving SNAP, TANF or SSI benefits
- Families under 100% of Federal Poverty Level

Potentially Eligible:

- Families at 100-130% FPL: Can enroll up to 35%
- Families over 130 FPL: Can enroll up to 10%
