- 1. Washington Long-Term Care Insurance Program Discussion
  - Amended Resolution 22-004, regarding Washington's Long-Term Care Insurance Program

Councilmember Nehring explained the proposed resolution requesting the Governor to delay the implementation and extend the opt out period of the Washington Long-Term Care Insurance Program. He also responded to questions regarding the limited private long-term care insurance options.

Councilmember Low expressed support of the resolution.

**ACTION:** Councilmember Nehring made a motion to approve Resolution 22-004. Councilmember Low seconded the motion.

Brief discussion ensued relating to amending the resolution since the Governor and Legislature are already working to delay implementation and address the issues of the program.

Councilmember Nehring made a motion to amend Resolution 22-004, by adding "consistent with implementation at the state level" at the end of the two enacting clauses. Councilmember Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The vote was called and the motion to approve Resolution 22-004, as amended, carried unanimously.
