**RECOGNIZING OCTOBER 2022**  
**AS CYBERSECURITY MONTH IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

*WHEREAS, Snohomish County recognizes that it has a vital role in identifying and protecting its residents and employees from, and in responding to, cyber threats that may have significant impact to our individual and collective security and privacy; and*

*WHEREAS, critical infrastructure sectors are increasingly reliant on information systems and technology to support financial services, energy, telecommunications, transportation, utilities, health care, and emergency response system; and*

*WHEREAS, “it’s easy to stay safe online” campaign serves as the national cybersecurity public awareness campaign, implemented through a coalition of private companies, nonprofit, academic, and government organizations, working together to increase the understanding of cyber threats and empowering the American public to be safer and more secure online; and*

*WHEREAS, maintaining the security of technology and data is a shared responsibility in which each of us has a critical role to play, and awareness of computer security essentials will improve the security of Snohomish County’s information, infrastructure, and economy; and*

*WHEREAS, the President of the United States, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security ([www.dhs.gov/cyber](http://www.dhs.gov/cyber)), the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center ([www.msisac.org](http://www.msisac.org)), the National Association of State Chief Information Officers ([www.nascio.org](http://www.nascio.org)), and the National Cyber Security Alliance ([www.staysafeonline.org](http://www.staysafeonline.org)) all recognize October as National Cybersecurity Awareness Month;*


