Authority Granted: Approve and authorize the Executive to sign Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District concerning Utility Construction Associated with the Swamp Creek Bridge #503 Replacement Project, under RCW 39.34.

Background: Swamp Creek Bridge is a 41-foot long two span bridge that was built in 1960, between 228th St SW and 226 Place SW. It carries Locust Way over Swamp Creek between Bothell and Brier. Federal bridge replacement funds for the replacement project were received in 2020 and this bridge is identified in the [Snohomish County Public Works 2022 Annual Bridge Report](#).

The Swamp Creek Bridge #503 Replacement project is included in the Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) and the adopted Annual Construction Program (ACP) as item F.54. The new description of work includes the installation of up to 490 feet of 8-inch ductile iron restraint joint water main including fittings, routing through the new bridge wing walls and supporting the pipe with hangers under the bridge deck, insulating the exposed portion of the water main under the bridge deck and connections to the existing main, installation of a fire hydrant along with a water meter per the project plans.

Requested Action: For Council to move the motion to GLS on August 27, 2025, for consideration.
