Proposal: Motion 21-254 Date: August 17, 2021

Consideration:

The proposal would authorize the County Executive to execute a budget transfer between funds within the Facilities and Fleet's Maintenance Division, in accordance with SCC 4.26.130¹.

Background:

The previously approved 2021 budget included program 031 (Facilities Maintenance) to manage the maintenance of the newly remodeled North Sound Behavioral Health Treatment Center (NSBHTC). A budget estimated at \$107,183 was included in to meet the maintenance needs of this facility for the budget year.

Current Proposal:

Scope: The Facilities and Fleet department requests Council to approve the move of these appropriations to its own program 036, titled "NSBHTC Maintenance". This will enable the Facilities and Fleet department to track the fiscal activities related to maintaining this facility separately in order to better plan out future budget and maintenance plans.

Duration: Program 036, "NSBHTC Maintenance" will allow the Facilities and Fleet department to continue to track the maintenance needs for this facility annually. This motion shall take effect immediately.

Fiscal Implications: There is a net zero impact to the budget. A transfer of budgetary appropriations within Fund 511 from Facilities Maintenance Program 031 and NSBHTC Maintenance Program 036 is needed to track maintenance spending for the new behavioral health facility.
