**Subject:** Naloxone Distribution Agreement Between Snohomish County and the City of Edmonds Police Department

**Scope:** The Snohomish County Department of Health is establishing an agreement with City of Edmonds Police Department under which the County will provide Naloxone in exchange for data regarding opioid overdoses. The data will be used to track demand for Naloxone and distribute it where it is most needed.

**Duration:** Upon execution through December 31, 2026

**Fiscal Impact:**  Current Year  Future-Year  N/A

There is no exchange of funds and no fiscal impact.

**Authority Granted:** Motion 24-102 authorizes the execution of an agreement with Snohomish County and City of Edmonds Police Department to implement a Naloxone Distribution Program.

**Background:** Snohomish County Council passed Ordinance No. 23-047 approving form agreements for naloxone distribution between Snohomish County and local jurisdictions within Snohomish County on June 7, 2023.

RCW 69.41.095 establishes that any person or “entity” (e.g., police department, homeless shelter) can obtain, possess, and administer naloxone.
