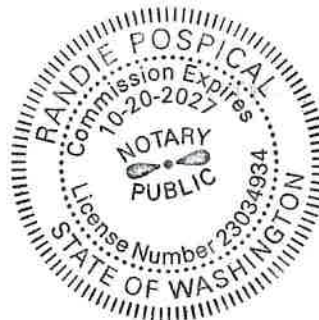

PROJECTS

Summary: The ordinance makes a supplemental appropriation in the General Fund, Health Department Fund, and Facilities Fund to cover the remaining contract costs for projects previously funded by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund. As approved by Motion 24-525, the County maximized costs incurred in 2024 that were eligible for Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) grant funds by charging General Fund costs to the ARPA CLFR Grant Fund. Projects funded by the ARPA Spending Plans submitted to Council in 2023 were budgeted in the ARPA Grant Fund and now need to be appropriated in the General Fund for completion. All projects were obligated and appropriated in the 2024 budget and carried forward into the 2025-2026 budget.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
