#### APPROVING EVERETT CITY'S INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT GF-022-02f

<u>Summary:</u> The Council appropriated \$5,000,000 for "Council Projects" in the 2023 adopted budget. The COVID-19 pandemic exposed weaknesses in systemic availability and access to resources and connections necessary to lead healthy, stable and independent lives. The City of Everett is working to address one of those health issues with this facility improvement. The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement through December 31, 2024, by which the County will reimburse the City of Everett for eligible expenses for the purchase of public restrooms, in the amount not to exceed \$250,000.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
