- ✓ RFP conducted March September 2024
- Contract signed February 2025



Implementation Vendor: In Process

- Progressing to contract negotiation in the competitive purchase process with <u>Highstreet IT</u> (based on RFP high-score)
- Oracle-certified and Oracle-only practice
- ✓ 90+% focused on government and public sector clients
- Contract negotiations beginning in June, target completion secondhalf of 2025



County ERP Engagement Progress

- ERP Communities: Supporting every department, office, and court through the change with a People-First approach.
- Phase 1: HR Focus: We're prioritizing HR processes and workloads, with the implementation kickoff planned for Q4.
- Stakeholder Input: Over 150 interviews have been conducted with HR specialists and staff with more planned.
- ✓ Widespread Awareness: Our "Can You Beat IT?" ERP game has sparked strong interest, with 350+ participants in just four weeks.
- ✓ **Kickoff:** March's ERP Town Hall with Oracle drew over 340 attendees.
- ✓ What's Next: A strategic leadership summit is scheduled for this summer to align priorities and ensure readiness.
