# **Consideration**

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-450 which would approve the redemption fee for an animal set by the Snohomish County Auditor.

# **Background**

In 2011, the Snohomish County Council adopted Ordinance 11-014 which authorized full recovery of costs through redemption fees for animals that have been confiscated or impounded, including costs related to apprehension, transportation, care, boarding, shelter facilities, and veterinary care including euthanasia and disposal. The ordinance also added language to Snohomish County Code 9.12.110 requiring the director of the animal control agency to establish redemption fees for cost recovery to be approved by Council motion by January 1st of each year.

In 2021, the Animal Control Impound rate was set at \$382 and the Stray Impound rate was set at \$195.

# **Current Proposal**
