0	WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, the Washington State Department of Health confirmed
1	the first reported case of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in the United States in Snohomish
2	County, Washington. COVID-19, a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death,
13	is caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been
4	previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person;

6	WHEREAS, since January 21, 2020, the disease has spread throughout the United States.
17	On January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services secretary Alex
8	Azar declared a public health emergency for COVID-19, beginning January 27, 2020. On
9	February 29, 2020, Washington State Governor Jay Inslee proclaimed a public health emergency
20	for COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, the Snohomish County Health Officer proclaimed a
21	countywide public health emergency for COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, Executive Dave Somers issued a "Local Proclamation of Emergency Snohomish County" for COVID-19 (the
22 23	"Emergency"). On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared
23 24	COVID-19 a National Emergency;
25	COVID-17 a National Emergency,
26	WHEREAS, on March 10, 2021, the United States Congress passed the American Rescue
27	Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA"),
28	
29	WHEREAS, Section 9901 of ARPA created a Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and
30	a Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury provided direct relief to units of
33	local government through the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds ("CLFR"); and
34	WHEREAC Contaminate Country has associated CLED founds from the Haited Clean
35 36	WHEREAS, Snohomish County has received CLFR funds from the United States Department of Treasury.
