Subject: Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue for Information Technology Services.

Scope: This is a new agreement that would allow the Snohomish County Department of Information Technology (SCIT) to provide technology and network services to the Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue (SRFR) using the County Work Order (WO) system and process.

Fiscal Impact: Current Year Multi-Year N/A

The total cost of all WO against this agreement shall not exceed \$100,000.00 over the five (5) year term.

Authority Granted: Approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute an Interlocal Agreement and associated work orders and amendments between Snohomish County and the Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue to provide information technology services, under RCW 39.34 and SCC 3.04.210 and 3.01.140(11).

Background: The SCIT has negotiated with the SRFR for use of the County's technology infrastructure and expertise. The proposed agreement includes the terms and conditions of the agreement. Each Work Order will include a description of the specific services, term and cost from the published rate or fee schedule. The scope of information technology goods and information services to be provided are limited to the following:

- Space in the Meet-Me-Room rack to mount Agency's network equipment in the SCIT data center.
- Provide cross-connections to connect to other agencies or services located in the SCIT data center.
- Assist in the planning, management, control, operations, and use of integrated cities, jurisdictional, government and County networks, telecommunications, information processing, systems and equipment required by the Agency; provide Internet Service Provider (ISP) services.
- Coordination of the planning, management, control, operation, and use of information services, backbone network, telecommunications, information processing, equipment, purchased services and proprietary software required by the Agency.
