### **Consideration**

The proposed motion would provide approval and authorization of the County Executive to sign an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Snohomish County and the Alderwood Water and Sewer District concerning Utility Construction associated with the Locust Way-Logan Road Intersection Improvement project, under SCC 13.01.020(5).

### **Background**

Washington State RCW 39.34 provides for interlocal agreements between local agencies within the state for mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner beneficial to both agencies. Snohomish County has approved Transportation Improvement Project #D.02.03, for intersection improvements to Locust Way-Logan Road located east of the Brier city limits, in unincorporated Snohomish County.

The Alderwood Water and Sewer District currently has utilities within the County right-of-way and is required by franchise conditions and state law to relocate these facilities to accommodate County initiated public road improvements.

### **Current Proposal**

*Scope:* An Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Alderwood Water and Sewer district is sought for the utility construction and the relocation of water mains and appurtenances, and the relocation of sanitary sewer mains and appurtenances and associated utility work with the Locust Way-Logan Road Intersection project.

*Duration:* The duration of the agreement is from execution and until all obligations are discharged pursuant to the provisions therein.

*Fiscal Implications:* The projected reimbursable construction and labor costs associated with the scope of work is \$1,532,115.78.

**Budget Impacts:** All costs associated with the utility work will be paid by the Alderwood Water and Sewer District.
