Authority Granted: Approve and authorize the County Executive to sign the Agreement with Pacific Security for Security Guard Services at the Everett New Start Center until renovations are complete or replaced by another security firm, whichever comes first, under SCC 3.04.140(11).

Background: Snohomish County Facilities had a previous Piggyback agreement with Washington State Department of Enterprise Service (DES) for Security Guard Services, under motion [24-395](#). This contract has expired, and due to a delay in the DES process, a new contract will not be available until June 2025, causing a gap in security services. Pacific Security has agreed to a contract to provide immediate 24/7 security guard services at the Everett New Start Center for the short term, which may be extended.
