Background: On December 13, 2023, Council passed Motion 23-519² approving Amendment #3 to the PSTAA Interlocal Agreement with Everett Community College. This Amendment approved the 2023-2024 Services and Expenditure Plan in the amount of \$191,730.

In accordance with Ordinance 22-072, the County Executive approved Amendment #4 to the Interlocal. The Amendment reallocates \$24,289.97 in unspent PSTAA funds to Everett Community College for a total of \$216,019.97. Under this amendment, program allocations for supplies and indirect costs increased.
