The five members shall be recommended by the executive and appointed by the county council. The executive shall recommend candidates representing a spectrum of citizens, public interest groups and businesses. Candidates shall be residents of Snohomish county or firms licensed to do business in Snohomish county.

(d) ((Four))Six members shall be selected, two to represent commercial solid waste collection firms, one voting and one non-voting; ((and)) two to represent commercial recycling firms, one voting and one non-voting; and two to represent commercial organics firms, one voting and one non-voting. (e) One ex officio, non-voting representative from the Snohomish county solid waste division.

(f) One ex officio, non-voting representative from the department of ecology.

The regular membership of the solid waste advisory committee may appoint auxiliary members for a specific time period to serve on the committee in a non-voting capacity, for the purpose of providing specific information, technical advice, information of a general nature which is pertinent to the committee's activities or any other form of assistance which will aid the committee in carrying out its purposes.

(3) Term of Office. Terms of office for regular members shall be for a two-year period from the date of appointment, whether the member is appointed at the commencement of an initial term or at a point thereafter.
