The intent is for the contractor to provide between 20-30 hours per week on this contract. A detailed summary of these duties is outlined in the scope of services under Schedule A and include, but are not limited to: Overseeing and providing healthcare for all inmates. Consultation and evaluation of inmate's medical needs. Available 24/7 in person or telephonically, and if not available has arranged a backup authorized provider. Document inmate charts and medical findings. Available by phone for consultations with jail practitioners to determine need for hospital care, dedication changes, or other treatment. Review and oversee medical services provided by nursing staff, including prisoner complaints about medical services. Schedule B outlines the compensation under the contract, which is \$176/per hour for on-site services; non-routine and emergent needs by phone \$176/per half hour; education allowance of up to \$1,500.

Background:

Snohomish County Code 5.12, enacted in 1994, established local health and welfare laws relating to the Snohomish County Jail. Specifically, SCC 5.12.010 requires the Sheriff's Corrections Bureau to designate a health authority that is responsible for health care

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services to inmates. The health authority may be a physician, health administrator, or agency, but when it's not a physician, a physician must be used for medical judgment.
