# PUBLIC AGENCY IMPACTS, BY THE NUMBERS

*Total Public Assistance Impacts Over \$18 Million*

- SNOHOMISH COUNTY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT: \$14,400,000
- INCORPORATED CITIES: \$2,700,000
- OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES: \$46,500

# ASSESSING IMPACT ON RESIDENTS



## Windstorm Damage Survey



- 230 SURVEYS SUBMITTED
- OVER \$5.5 MILLION IN PRIVATE PROPERTY IMPACTS
- CONNECT WITH ASSESSOR'S OFFICE FOR TAX RELIEF



# DIGGING DEEPER ON SURVEY RESULTS

- REVIEWED RESULTS WITH STATE EMD AND FEMA
- WHILE MANY WERE IMPACTED, FEW MET FEMA CRITERIA
  - NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY DAMAGE
  - INSURED LOSSES
  - NON-PRIMARY RESIDENCES





# STATE INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE

- GOVERNOR MADE IA FUNDS AVAILABLE, \$1 MILLION ACROSS THREE COUNTIES
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:
  - <80% LOCAL MEAN INCOME, AND
  - UNINSURED OR UNDERINSURED, AND
  - PRIMARY RESIDENCE MAJOR OR DESTROYED, OR
    - HAVE DISABILITY (MEDICAL/DENTAL ASSISTANCE ONLY)
  - SOME CATEGORIES OF ASSISTANCE REQUIRE APPLYING FOR A SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION LOAN

Category	Maximum Amount
Extended Sheltering Assistance	Up to 3 weeks in hotel at per diem rates
Home Repair	\$43,600
Other Needs	\$43,600, total of below categories
Household Needs Grant	\$375-\$1,125
Transportation Repair or Replace	\$50-\$9,200
Childcare Assistance Maximum	\$7,000 (\$3,500 per child)
Personal Property	Based on value of loss, may not exceed \$43,600
Medical/Dental Assistance	\$630



# SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION ASSISTANCE

- DISASTER LOAN OPERATIONS CENTER AT THE FAIR PARK
  - DATES AND HOURS
- RESIDENTIAL REPAIRS UP TO \$500,000
- PERSONAL PROPERTY UP TO \$100,000
- NO INTEREST ACCRUED OR PAYMENTS DUE FOR 12 MONTHS



## Physical damage loans

Loans to cover repairs and replacement of physical assets damaged in a declared disaster.



## Mitigation assistance

Expanded funding to make improvements to eliminate future damage.



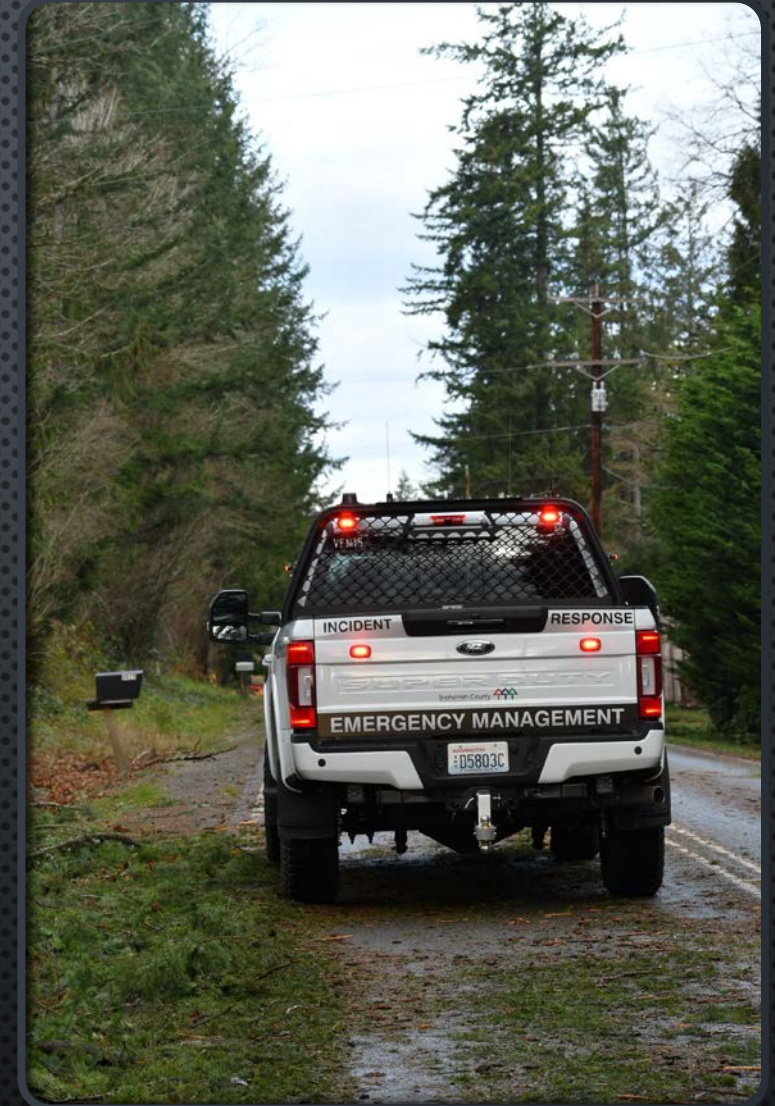
## Economic Injury Disaster Loans

Funding to cover small business operating expenses after a declared disaster.



# NEXT STEPS

- DEM EMAILING PEOPLE WHO COMPLETED THE SURVEY
  - INITIAL TRANCHE ALREADY EMAILED, AWAITING STATE CONFIRMATION ON REMAINDER
  - INVITING THOSE WITH ELIGIBLE DAMAGE TO COMPLETE APPLICATION FOR IA
  - HSD WILL WORK WITH OSJ, THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, AND ITS OWN NETWORK OF PROVIDERS TO REACH OUT TO HOUSEHOLDS THAT MAY NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS OR ARE NOT ABLE TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY ONLINE TO ENSURE THOSE RESIDENTS HAVE ACCESS TO THE SUPPORTS FOR WHICH THEY ARE ELIGIBLE
  - HSD WILL IMPLEMENT WITH VOA
- EVERYONE WITH DAMAGES CAN APPLY FOR SBA LOANS—EITHER ONLINE OR AT THE FAIR PARK
