CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF JOSH CASSON TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, SCC 2.50.080 establishes the creation of the Snohomish County Ethics Commission, consisting of five members nominated by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, any person with knowledge of a Snohomish County Ethics Code violation by a county employee, or any person dealing with Snohomish County government, may file a complaint with the Snohomish County Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is the Commission's duty to examine questionable behavior, as defined by the Snohomish County Ethics Code, and to resolve complaints; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County's Ethics Commission exists as a non-biased resource for the community and can provide information and solutions; and

WHEREAS, Josh Casson has a history of serving the public through various commissions including with the United States Marine Corps, and is an experienced leader who is adept in management of cross functional teams across multiple operations and facilities simultaneously, and he currently serves on the Ethics Commission and is eligible for reappointment;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council confirms the reappointment of Josh Casson to the Snohomish County Ethics Commission Position 5 to serve a second term that expires June 30, 2026.
