Consideration:

Approve contract Amendment B with the Washington Department of Commerce for the Bonneville Power Administration Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program (BPA LIEE).

Background:

The County received funding from BPA LIEE which was included in the 2022 Facilities and Fleet Grant Work Plan, approved by the Council through Motion 21-364. These funds are to provide program administration and delivery of weatherization and repair services to low-income persons in Snohomish County in areas served by BPA.

The current contract amount is for \$209,470. Additional funding has been provided for the program which increased the total amount of the County's contract to \$418,779. Because the additional funds exceed what was included in the grant work plan by more than \$50,000, Council approval is required for the County to accept the additional funds.

Current Proposal:

Scope: This amendment would add \$209,309 to the total contract amount, increasing the total do not exceed amount to \$418,779.

Duration: No change, contract termination date remains September 30, 2023

Fiscal Implications: \$209,309 – County will receive this amount.
