<u>Authority Granted:</u> Approve and authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment 2 to the Technology Solution Contract between Snohomish County and Open Text, under SCC 3.04.140(8).

Background: In 2018, Snohomish County entered into a software license agreement and technology solution contract for professional services with Open Text Inc., per the Washington State Department of Enterprise Services Master Contract No.07814-002 and the Snohomish County Statement of Work, as a "Technology Solution Contract for an Enterprise Content Management Solution".

The provided technology solution software provides an electronic content management system (ECM) for Snohomish County Planning and Development Services (PDS). The current Open Text ECM platform allows for the implementation of critical software solutions to the PDS strategic technology plan.
