(a) Finance and economic development - ((second and fourth Tuesday at 10:30 a.m.)) first and third Monday at 1:30 p.m.

(b) Law and justice/human services - second and fourth Monday at 1:30 p.m.;

(c) Conservation, sustainability and recreation - ((second and fourth Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.)) second and fourth Monday at 11:00 a.m.

(d) Planning and community development - ((first and third Tuesday at 10:30 a.m.)) second and fourth Monday at 2:30 p.m.

(e) Public works and infrastructure - ((first and third Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.)) first and third Monday at 11:00 a.m.

At the hearing, the Council may consider Proposed Substitute Ordinance No. 22-022, which moves the Monday regular council meetings to Tuesdays, and all Council Standing Committees to Tuesdays. A summary is as follows:

(a) Finance and economic development - ((second and fourth Tuesday at 10:30 a.m.)) second and fourth Tuesday at 10:00 a.m.

(b) Law and justice/human services - ((second and fourth Monday at 1:30 p.m.)) second and fourth Tuesday at 1:00 p.m.

(c) Conservation, sustainability and recreation - ((second and fourth Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.)) second and fourth Tuesday at 11:00 a.m.

(d) Planning and community development - ((first and third Tuesday at 10:30 a.m.)) first and second Tuesday at 11:00 a.m.

(e) Public works and infrastructure - ((first and third Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.)) first and third Tuesday at 10:00 a.m.
