Scope: Ordinance 23-130 approves Amendment No. 4 to a contract with

Whatcom County increasing funding for the Cannabis & Commercial Tobacco prevention program by \$45,000. This brings the total for the contract period to \$142,928. The amendment extends the contract

period until June 30, 2024.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Ordinance 23-130 would authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment No. 4.

Background: Whatcom County receives funds from the Washington State Department of Health for cannabis and tobacco prevention. Whatcom County subcontracted with the Snohomish County Health District to implement strategies aimed at reducing initiation and use of cannabis and commercial tobacco by youth ages 12-20. The agreement and Amendment No. 1 were transitioned to Snohomish County as part of the County and Health District Integration.

Amendment No. 2 increased program funding by \$56,000 and changed the duration of the ILA. This was approved through Ordinance 23-018¹ on April 12, 2023. Amendment No. 3 added \$14,928 to the contract and was approved through Ordinance 23-069² on June 27, 2023.
