Authority Granted: Authorize Fleet Services to sell twenty-five (25) units of surplus ER&R and Property Management assets listed in Attachment A to the motion, in accordance with SCC 4.46.

Background: Upon yearly review with respective departments, equipment can be determined surplus. This can happen under standard fleet rotation, or if a department has determined the unit is no longer necessary for county operations. Sale prices are estimated and included in the surplus list to Council. Estimated sales revenue is based on historical results of similar sales. Sales can occur through public auction, or negotiated sale, direct sale, lease, or trade to other government entities. Sales proceeds are deposited into the corresponding County department reserve funds for future equipment replacement in accordance with SCC 4.34.025 and SCC 4.34.055.
