Authorize the Snohomish County Executive to sign the agreement with C&S Engineers, Inc.

## **Background:**

Snohomish County Airport (Paine Field) has need of professional assistance with various aeronautical planning studies, layouts and updates, as well of development of various forms, policies and best practices related to airport business development. C&S Engineers, Inc. (C&S) has been selected on the basis of their qualifications to perform the on-call Airport Planning and Business Services identified in Schedule F of RFQ 24-011BC. C&S has been in business for over 55 years, providing aviation support services to over 220 airports in that time, with over 120 staff currently dedicated solely to airports. This contract will be administered over four years, with the ability to extend for additional time at the option of the County. The required funds will be provided from the Airport fund and supplemented with grant funding when available. The total expenditure shall not exceed \$1,000,000.
