Consideration:

Approve the appointment of Kyle Strand and Charles Wichert to the Snohomish County Ethics Commission.

Background:

The Snohomish County Ethics Commission¹ (Commission) was established in 1991 through Ordinance 91-084. The Commission was created to receive ethics violation complaints and to administer the Code of Ethics as established in Snohomish County Code. The Commission is comprised of five members appointed by the Executive and confirmed by the majority of the County Council. Members may serve no more than two three-year terms.

Currently, there are two vacancies on the Ethics Commission. If both proposed motions are approved, the Commission would be fully staffed.
