### **Background**

Snohomish County recently approved Motions 22-330<sup>1</sup> and 22-338<sup>2</sup>, authorizing the execution of two (2) purchase and sale agreements buying hotels intended for use as bridge and permanent supportive housing.

### **Current Proposal**

*Scope:* Ordinance 22-033 amends Snohomish County Code Sections 2.400.020 and 2.400.065 placing a requirement that any agreement with a third-party service include a program agreement or code of conduct conditioning a participants' housing on the participation in drug treatment if they have a substance use disorder. The program agreement or code of conduct must also be present if the county is delivering the services to participants.
