**Subject:** Approving Amendment No. 1 to an agreement for spill response at Public Works managed and operated facilities

**Scope:** Amendment No. 1 adds \$100,000 to the not-to-exceed amount of an agreement between Snohomish County Public Works and Graymar Environmental Services, LLC for Public Works Spill Response.

Additionally, the underlying agreement listed the contractor as Graymar Environmental Services, Inc., which is replaced by the Amendment based on Articles of Conversion and Certificate of Formation on file with the Washington Secretary of State, effective August 30, 2024.

**Duration:** There are no changes to the term of the original agreement which concludes 12/31/2026 unless extended. There are two-additional one-year terms allowed.

**Authority Granted:** authorizes the County Executive to sign Amendment No. 1

**Background:** Both public road right-of-way and public works buildings and/or solid waste facilities may experience the accumulation of contaminants, experience minor spills, illegal dumping or large spill events.

Graymar Environmental Services, LLC was the successful bidder in response to RFP 23-057 with the original agreement executed on March 27, 2024 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000 via [Motion 24-091](#).

To date, Public Works has utilized \$140,862 of the original contract amount (primarily on the pickup and processing of abandoned buckets or oil or other liquid from the roadside and cleanup of hazardous spills related to collisions) and has the need for additional funds for this purpose.
