PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-008  
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE  
TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MUKILTEO FOR THE  
PHASE I ANNEXATION AREA

**Background:** This ordinance proposes to authorize the County Executive to execute an interlocal agreement (ILA) with the City of Mukilteo to facilitate the orderly transfer of jurisdiction and services regarding the Mukilteo Phase I Annexation Area. The 84-acre Annexation Area is located east of State Route 525, also known as Mukilteo Speedway, and along Beverly Park Road. The Annexation Area is adjacent to and east of the existing boundaries of the City of Mukilteo.

A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:  
**Section 1:** Adopts recitals, findings of fact, and conclusions.

**Section 2:** Authorizes the County Executive to execute the ILA with the City of Mukilteo.
