### **Consideration**

Proposed Motion 23-020 would authorize the County Executive to execute the *Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Gold Bar and Snohomish County Concerning Provision of Building, Construction, Fire Plan Review and Code Inspection Services*.

### **Background and Analysis**

The Snohomish County Fire Marshal's Office (FMO) provides occasional fire inspection services to other agencies and jurisdictions as authorized by Interlocal Agreement (ILA). Gold Bar and the County have negotiated terms for an ILA where the County would provide building, construction, fire plan review, and code inspection services to the city when request by the city. This agreement would remain in effect until December 31, 2026, and it provides Planning and Development Services the authority to extend it for up to 10 years.

This ILA would have a neutral budgetary effect because the FMO would receive an hourly fee-for-service to recovery its costs. The full text of the ILA is in the briefing packet as Exhibit A to Motion 23-020.

### **Current Proposal**

*Summary:* Motion 23-020 would authorize Executive to execute the ILA with Gold Bar.
