Subject: Approving an interlocal agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Stanwood for flood risk mitigation.

Scope: The City of Stanwood will oversee the management of a capital project to repair approximately 1000 linear yards of a flood-damaged levee and a site in need of subsurface remediation near downtown Stanwood. The damaged portion of the levee, owned and maintained by Diking District 7, currently protects from flood risk approximately 2200 acres of agricultural land, the City of Stanwood, surrounding communities and businesses, and State Highway 532. The County will fund certain emergency repairs as described in the agreement and will provide up to \$1,750,000 in funds in support of the project.

Background: A portion of Skagit Bay Dike was damaged during the winter of 2025-2026. The City of Stanwood is coordinating local efforts to perform certain emergency repairs and has requested financial assistance. Funds being provided are funds that were originally provided to the County through ARPA.
