**Background:** The ordinance approves recommendations to award Snohomish County Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program funds and direct the Executive to execute Interlocal Agreements with three special purpose districts to distribute the funds awarded in 2024. In the 2024 Budget, Snohomish County Council established a Snohomish County Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program having a total funding amount of \$180,000. Surface Water Management convened a grant review process for the program and these three districts were selected to receive grant funds based upon the criteria of the application process. The ordinance authorizes the Executive to sign Interlocal Agreements with Snohomish County Dike Improvement District No. 1, French Slough Flood Control District and the Marshland. It further authorizes the Director of the Snohomish County Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to approve and execute a written amendment with those districts to extend or renew each Interlocal for up to one additional one-year term. The term of the agreements are from execution to acceptance of completed work, to be conducted prior to December 31, 2025.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
