Motion 25-502 authorizes the County Executive to sign a Professional Services Agreement with Geoengineers Inc. for Paine Field former Fire Pit Agreed Order Implementation at Snohomish County Airport at Paine Field.

Background:

This Agreement is the product of County RFQ-25-0504BC. GeoEngineers Inc. was selected as the most qualified company to perform the services required by the Department of Ecology Agreed Order. Snohomish County Airport has been investigating environmental contamination at the Former Fire Pit Site since 1998. On May 27, 2025, Department of Ecology provided written notice that the Airport is a Potentially Liable Party (PLP) for the environmental contamination at the former Fire Pit Training Pit.

The term of this agreement may be extended or renewed for up to one (1) additional two (2) year term.

This agreement is not to exceed \$2,254,510.
