

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-114

APPROVING CONSOLIDATED CONTRACT WITH WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO APPROVE ANY FUTURE AMENDMENTS

Background: The ordinance approves a consolidated coniract with Washington State Department of Health (DOH) and provide authority to approve any future amendments. This funding allows Snotkmish County Health Department to continue providing core public health services. The Department receives the majority of its grant funding through a consolidated contract with the DOH that is used for many different public health services including maternal and child health block grant, recreational shellish activities, tuberculosis control, and many more. The Department anticipates future amendments to the consolidated contract to add new programmatic work and further adjust the activities and deliverables for existing programmatic work. The term of the contract is from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2027. At the Public Heaning, the Council may consider amendment to the proposed ordinance.
